**ORDER**

At a session of said Court held

This Court, having held a hearing in this matter July 10, 2015 hereby orders:


1. The court is summarily dismissing the contempt proceedings against all three minor children;
2. The court agrees with the guardian ad litem's recommendations regarding the best interests of the children;
3. The court finds it is in the children's best interest to grant father's and the guardian ad litem's motions to allow the children to attend summer camp, pursuant to the custody act, including MCL 722.27(1)(e);
4. Children's Village is to facilitate transportation of the minor children to the summer camp;
5. Parents are allowed to visit in person only per the camp's policy and procedure so long as they are accompanied by the parenting time supervisor Art Gallagher;
6. Neither parents is allowed to telephone the children or send mail or other communications to the children at camp;
7. All communication during visits with the minor children while Mr. Gallagher is supervising must take place in English;
8. Mother must provide all of the children's camp necessities to the summer camp;
9. The parents are to share the cost of the camp;


10. The court preserves the issue of appropriate division of camp costs;
11. Both parents must take the children's images off all social media and the internet;
12. Both parents shall not allow the children's images to be published;
13. The court issues a Protective Order that the media shall not publish the children's images;
14. The court also orders parental alienation counseling as coordinated by the guardian ad litem;
15. The court asks the media to respect the privacy of the children and the camp to allow them to have as normal an existence as possible;
16. Neither party may address any aspect of this case with the children;
17. The camp shall work with the guardian ad litem and parenting time supervisor to facilitate visits according to camp policy;
18. The attorneys for the minor children: Karen Cook, Jeffrey Schwartz, and Michael Dean are released;
19. The letters received by Children's Village from the New York attorney are to be given to Plaintiff Mother subject to a protective order;
20. Those letters are not to be disseminated;
21. A review shall be held in this matter July 20, 2015 at 9:00 AM.


